ESIF

European structural and investment funds

• **Objective:** Invest in job creation and a sustainable and healthy European economy and environment.

European structural and investment funds:

- European regional development fund (ERDF)
- European social fund (ESF)
- European agricultural fund for rural development (EAFRD)
- Others

How the funds are managed

- Who? EU Member States
- What? Partnership agreements -> Investment programmes
- Areas:
 - jobs, growth and investment
 - justice and fundamental rights
 - other

European Regional Development Fund — ERDF

- Activities
- Useful for scaling up the EU intends it to be used for investments in existing infrastructure, education and services
- Elibigility: all EU Member States are eligible for ERDF

European Social Fund — ESF

- Activities
- Useful for **deinstitutionalization** the EU intends it to promote family support, rehabilitation, independent living schemes, etc.
- Useful for human capital opportunities for staff training and education
- Elibigility: all EU Member States are eligible for ESF

European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development — EAFRD

- Helping "the rural areas of the EU to meet the wide range of economic, environmental and social challenges of the 21st century"
- Useful for supporting deinstitutionalization can support deinstitutionalization within rural regions
- Elibigility: EU Member States

- Programme Countries can fully take part in the Programme: all EU Member States, former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Turkey

Horizon 2020

- Thematic Categories: Energy, Environment, Health, Industry, Information and Communication, Technologies, Justice, Security, Social Affairs and Human Rights, Space, Telecommunications, Transport, Youth, Economic growth and competitiveness
- Beneficiaries: Private Sector, Public Sector Bodies, Non-Profit Organizations, Academic institutions and research centers
- Budget: EUR 79.5 billion for the 2014-2020 period
- Website for call for proposals: <u>H2020 calls</u>
- **Overall objective**: building a society and an economy based on knowledge and innovation across the EU by promoting research, development and innovation

Three mutually reinforcing priorities:

- Excellent Science: supports world-class science research talent and support development of state-of-the-art research infrastructure
- Industrial Leadership: speed up the development of technologies and help innovative European SMEs to grow
- Societal Challenges: focus on health, demographic changed wellbeing; inclusive and innovative societies

PROACT

- 50 000 000 multimorbid patients; €700 000 000 000 spent on chronic disease management
- Promote efficiency through home-based integrated care
- Better patient engagement ownership of one's health
- Better workflow management deliver more with less
- Innovative healthcare facilitating flexible patient-centric models
- Home-based healthcare supported by new communication technologies
- Funded by Horizon 2020

PROACT

Activities:

- The project will be developed in Ireland and Belgium and tested in Ireland, Belgium and Italy
- Work with healthcare institutions, individual patients, and other stakeholders
- Disseminating, exploiting, communicating and commercializing the project results

Outputs:

- An integrated network for monitoring and reporting, that includes a mobile app
- a framework for data analysis and behavioural change to be implemented in the care system

- To give older adults access to more and better products and services for ageing well. These will help them to keep living independently in their own homes and to participate in economy and society for more years.
- To create a larger market for industry and especially SMEs at European level and improve EU competitiveness in ICT based products and services for ageing well.

Activities:

- Monitoring the rights of persons with mental disabilities
- Educate CSO's and individuals about the rights of persons with mental disabilities
- Develop hotline services for help and support
- Document at least 25 cases of rights violations,

Outputs:

Local CSO's will be monitoring capacities

- Promoting human rights
- Establishing an environment of tolerance, respect and inclusion
- Promoting and protecting the rights of persons with disabilities

- All EU Member States, Iceland (all specific objectives) and Liechtenstein (only for non-discrimination, racism, xenophobia, rights of persons with disabilities and equality between women and men)

- Thematic Categories: European Citizenship, Social Affairs and Human Rights, Labour Market
- Beneficiaries: Private Sector, Public Sector, Non-Profit Organizations

- Budget: EUR 439 million for the 2014-2020 period

➤ Objectives:

- Promote non–discrimination
- Combat racism, xenophobia, homophobia and other forms of intolerance
- Promote rights of persons with disabilities
- Promote equality between women and men and gender mainstreaming
- Prevent violence against children, young people, women and other groups at risk (Daphne)
- Promote the rights of the child
- Ensure the highest level of data protection
- Promote the rights deriving from Union citizenship
- Enforce consumer rights

Justice

- Promoting judicial cooperation
- Training legal staff on all levels
- Facilitate access to the judicial system
- Elibigility: All EU Member States, without UK and Denmark, including Albania


